Experience Italian culture, community, and the champion spirit that unites us all.

Since 2010, the Italian Day Festival Society has been writing a new chapter of Italo-Canadian heritage with Italian Day on The Drive — one of Vancouver's largest and most beloved cultural festivals, symbolically held in the heart of historic Little Italy.

Held annually on the second Sunday of June, the festival transforms Commercial Drive into a lively 14-block piazza alive with music, flavour, fashion, and community spirit. From food and wine gardens to live performances, artisan markets, family activities, and cultural showcases, Italian Day is where Vancouver comes together to live la dolce vita.

Each year, a new theme brings fresh expression to the celebration. In 2026, we honour Campione — the champion spirit that unites passion, perseverance, and pride. From past themes like Carnevale, Made in Italy, Amore, and Comunità, the festival continues to gather people of all ages around the Italian Day family table — sharing stories, laughter, and a love of culture.

Since its revival, Italian Day has grown into one of the city's most anticipated annual events, drawing hundreds of thousands of visitors while shining a spotlight on the heritage, creativity, and heart that define Little Italy.

Our History

WHERE HERITAGE INSPIRES THE FUTURE

Italian Day's story begins long before the festival itself — rooted in the culture, connection, and pride that built a community and still fuels it today.

From the 1940s to the 1980s, Commercial Drive grew into Vancouver's Little Italy — a true Italo-Canadian enclave built on hard work, community, and celebration. Italian immigrants transformed the area through business, parades, festivals, and family traditions, laying the foundation for the beloved neighbourhood we know today.

In 2010, a passionate group of community leaders revived this heritage by bringing Italian Day back to The Drive — and the response was immediate and incredible. What began as a grassroots festival quickly became a cultural phenomenon, drawing hundreds of thousands of visitors and earning recognition across Canada and beyond.

Rooted in tradition yet reborn with renewed energy, Italian Day embodies the enduring Campione spirit — honouring the champions of yesterday while inspiring the champions of tomorrow.

Italian Day continues to honour the past while championing a vibrant future — reminding us that the same drive that once built Little Italy still fuels our community pride on The Drive.

From the Italian parades of the 1960s to the first Italian Market Day in 1977, what began as a grassroots celebration of food, wine, and tradition evolved into today's Italian Day on The Drive.







Designations & Acknowledgments

Over the past decade, Italian Day's impact has extended far beyond the festival — shaping how Vancouver recognizes and celebrates its Italian roots.

In collaboration with the Commercial Drive Business Society and Il Centro Italian Cultural Centre, these efforts have helped preserve and elevate the legacy of Vancouver's Little Italy. In recognition of over 70 years of Italian heritage, the City of Vancouver officially designated eight blocks of Commercial Drive as Vancouver's historic Little Italy.



This proclamation, delivered in 2016, was a proud moment for the community — a celebration of legacy, partnership, and belonging. Since then, heritage crosswalks in the colours of the Italian flag and official recognition as part of Italian Heritage Month have cemented The Drive's status as a cultural landmark.

These milestones stand as lasting symbols of unity and pride — the very values that Campione 2026 celebrates. Today, Italian Day on The Drive continues to build on this legacy of recognition and pride, earning multiple Best of Vancouver awards and the Golden Owl Award for Festival of the Year (2025).

The tournament's official motto, "A time to make friends," perfectly captured the spirit and camaraderie of the Italian national team. Italy's World Cup triumph that year remains a testament to resilience, unity, and the true Campione spirit.
